Dear Ones in Christ, Greetings in our Lord and Redeemer Jesus Christ's name

The Psalmist said "Great Is The Lord and Greatly To Be Praised....." Ps48:1. Our Great God has done and continues to do Great Things for us. Our Theme Verse for the year 2016 is: "..... He that winneth Souls is wise...." Prov. 11:30b.

On January 7th we traveled to Northern Ghana to visit the brethren and minister the Word to them. We distributed Gospel literature, stationary, pens, pencils, rulers, health kits to more than 800 children and adults. We also visited a Leprosarium which has 77 inmates we were informed that they come from all over West Africa, Bukina Faso, Mali etc. Their greatest needs are food and clothing. It took 45 minutes to travel due to the condition of the road from Kpandai to Nkanchina No 2. We donated used Clothing, food items, health kits to help them, I shared a devotional to make this an adopt a Church project. The brethren are staying with them before proceeding to our church in the town with 100 strong members.

On Sunday the 10th we had a combined service with three other churches from nearby villages Kpandai, Naakodo and Kwatape. After the service the ladies shared with us some needs they have. The women's fellowship shared with us that they need some seed funds to help them generate some income to help their families and the church work. The projects that need seed money are Shea butter production and local soap production. Each group will need approximately \$250 as seed money. We feel this is in the right direction since it is better to teach how to fish than to provide fish. These people are in extreme poverty with shea nuts all around them and they rot year after year because they do not have the funds to process them. We are therefore appealing to all our supporters to consider taking on this project. A family of the church as a whole can help bring this to pass for God's glory. Please let Bro. Alive FM: On our way to the brethren in Northern Ghana we spotted a man at the station who has promised to help with the effective running of the Station. True to his word he brought a Radio Technician who has brought us a temporary transmitter for a 6 month test. He did fix it and now we are covering more than a 60 mile radius. This is an answer to our prayers. We need to replace the borrowed one by August. One person accepted the Lord when I preached on the night of January 7th. The subject was who is a true Christian. God is at work.



February was a celebration month, my family and the church, planned a celebration for my birthday on Feb. 7th. My birthday was on February 3rd. It was beyond my expectations. To God be the Glory.

We are presently preparing for the annual Spurgeon Bible Conference scheduled for March 18th to 20th. It will be preceded by a pastoral training from the 15th to the 17th. Our dear brother Pastor Tim Bantle is coming with his dear wife from Grace Baptist Church - Marion N.Y to be the main Speaker. The Theme is: Discipleship and growth. II Peter 3:18. Our brethren from the churches in Northern Ghana wanted to come but they are faced with the problem of transportation, the fare is \$29 per person in and out. The total for 100 brethren is \$2900. They are requesting whatever help our brethren in USA and Accra can help them with. Last Sunday a dear brother who is now with GE donated \$25.00 to help. I know time is short but I am sure you can help as the Lord leads.
